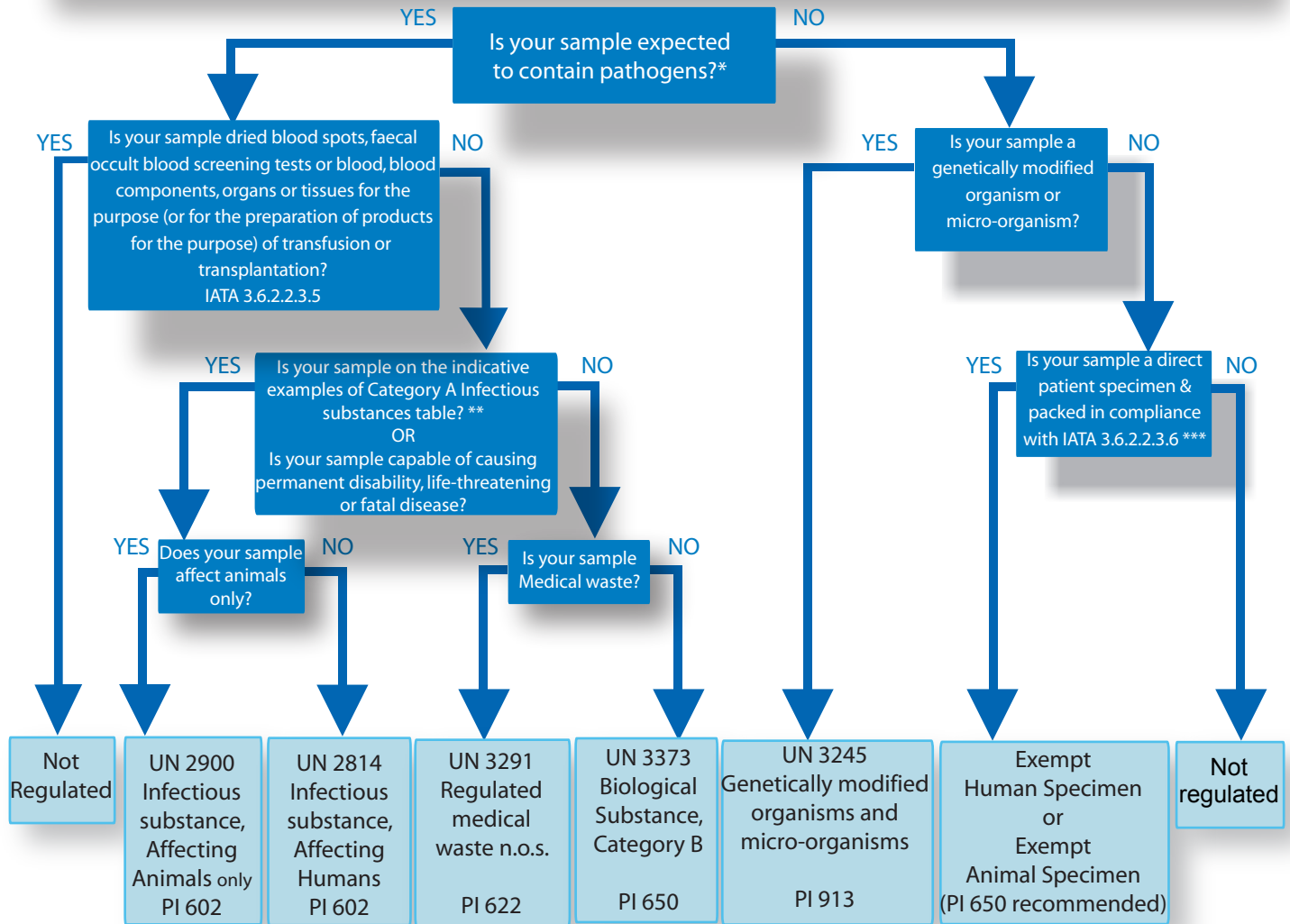


Classification Flow Chart
